1. ELECTION OF MAYOR

Nominations were invited for the election of Mayor of Tavistock Town Council for the 2022-23 Civic Year.

A nomination was received in respect of Councillor P Ward (proposed by Councillor A Hutton and seconded by Councillor Mrs A Johnson).

There being no other nominations it was:

RESOLVED THAT Councillor P Ward be elected Mayor of Tavistock Town Council for the 2022-23 Civic Year.

The Mayor was invested with the Chain of Office by the Retiring Mayor, Councillor A Hutton. The new Mayor signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office and thanked the Council for the opportunity to represent it as Mayor for the second term, and gave a commitment that his focus for the coming year would be his role as Mayor of Tavistock.

Retiring Mayoress, Mrs Sue Hutton, invested the new Mayoress, Mrs Jane Ward, with the Chain of Office.

Councillor Mrs A Johnson gave a tribute to the Retiring Town Mayor, Councillor A Hutton.

The Retiring Mayor was presented with a Past Mayor's badge by the new Mayor, and then expressed his appreciation to colleagues, Officers and staff for their support and endeavours over the past Civic Year. He also paid tribute to his Deputy Mayor, Councillor Mrs Ursula Mann, and his wife, as Mayoress, Mrs Sue Hutton.

2. ELECTION OF DEPUTY MAYOR

Nominations were invited for the election of Deputy Mayor of Tavistock Town Council for the 2022-2023 Civic Year.

A nomination was received in respect of Councillor J Ellis (proposed by Councillor Mrs U Mann and seconded by Councillor A Lewis).

There being no other nominations it was:

RESOLVED THAT Councillor J Ellis be elected Deputy Mayor of Tavistock Town Council for the 2022-23 Civic Year.

The Deputy Mayor was invested with the Chain of Office by the Retiring Deputy Mayor, Councillor Mrs U Mann. The new Deputy Mayor signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office and thanked the Council for the opportunity to represent it as Deputy Mayor for the following year.

3. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

An apology for absence had been received from Councillor J Moody.

4. DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

No declarations of interest were made at this point in the Meeting.

RESOLVED THAT Tavistock Town Council endorse the payment of an allowance of £2,000 to the Town Mayor to defray the expenses attached to this Office in pursuance of Section 15(5) of the Local Government Act 1972.

<u>Noted That</u> the new Mayor Declared an Interest and left the Meeting during consideration of the above, during which the Deputy Mayor took the Chair.

8. APPOINTMENT OF COMMITTEES & CONSULTATIVE GROUPS

The Council considered the list of proposed appointments of Committees and Consultative Groups (Appendix 2).

RESOLVED THAT the Membership of Committees and other fora as set out in the appended Schedule be endorsed.

9. PROGRAMME OF MEETINGS
