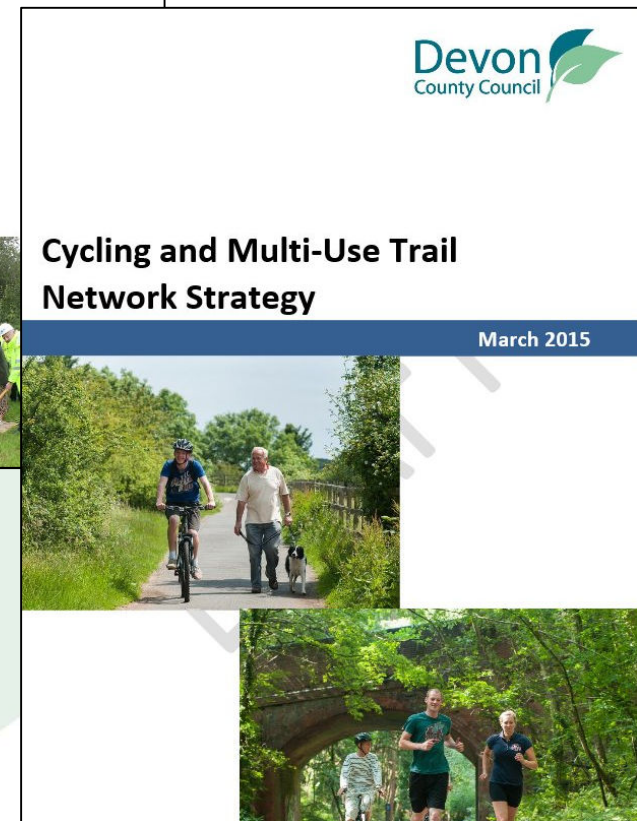
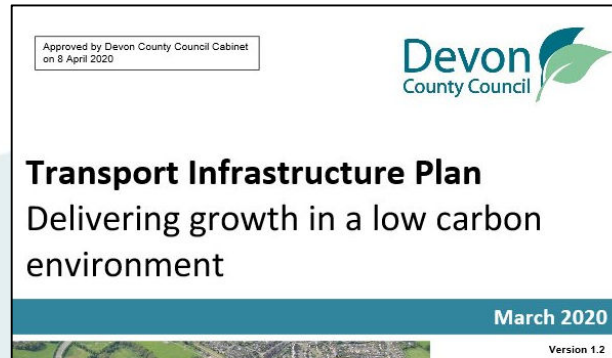

- Enable delivery of cycle aspirations in market and coastal towns

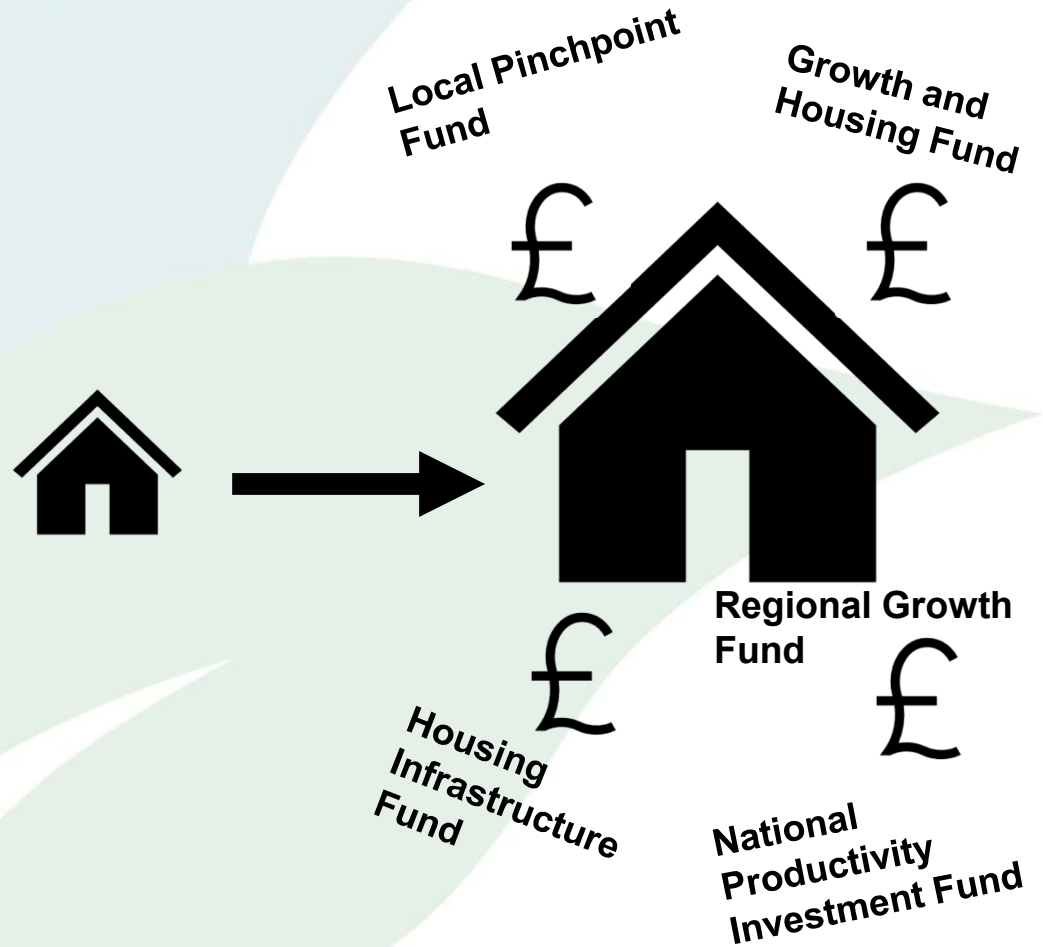
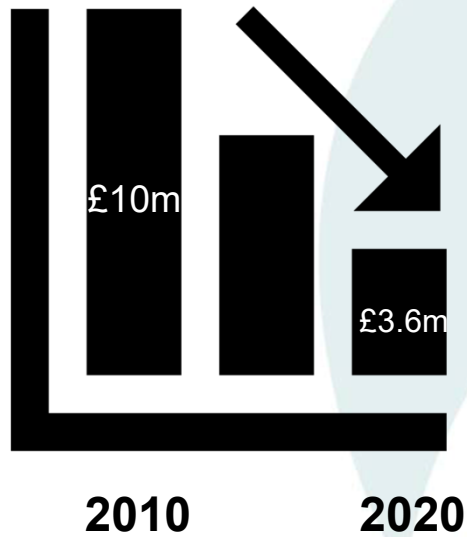
Devon Cycling and Walking Strategy: Scrutiny

 - Yelverton to Roborough

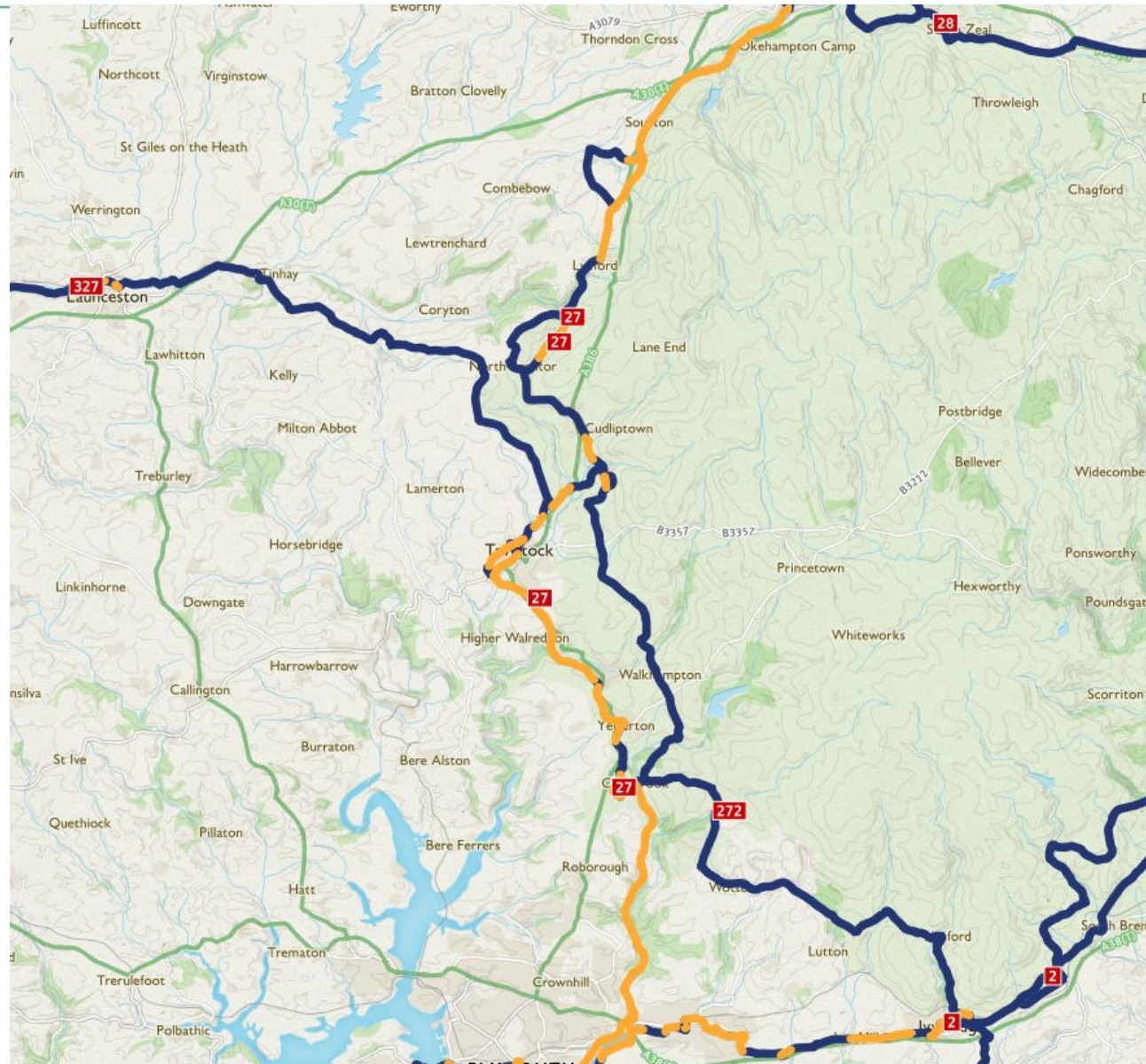

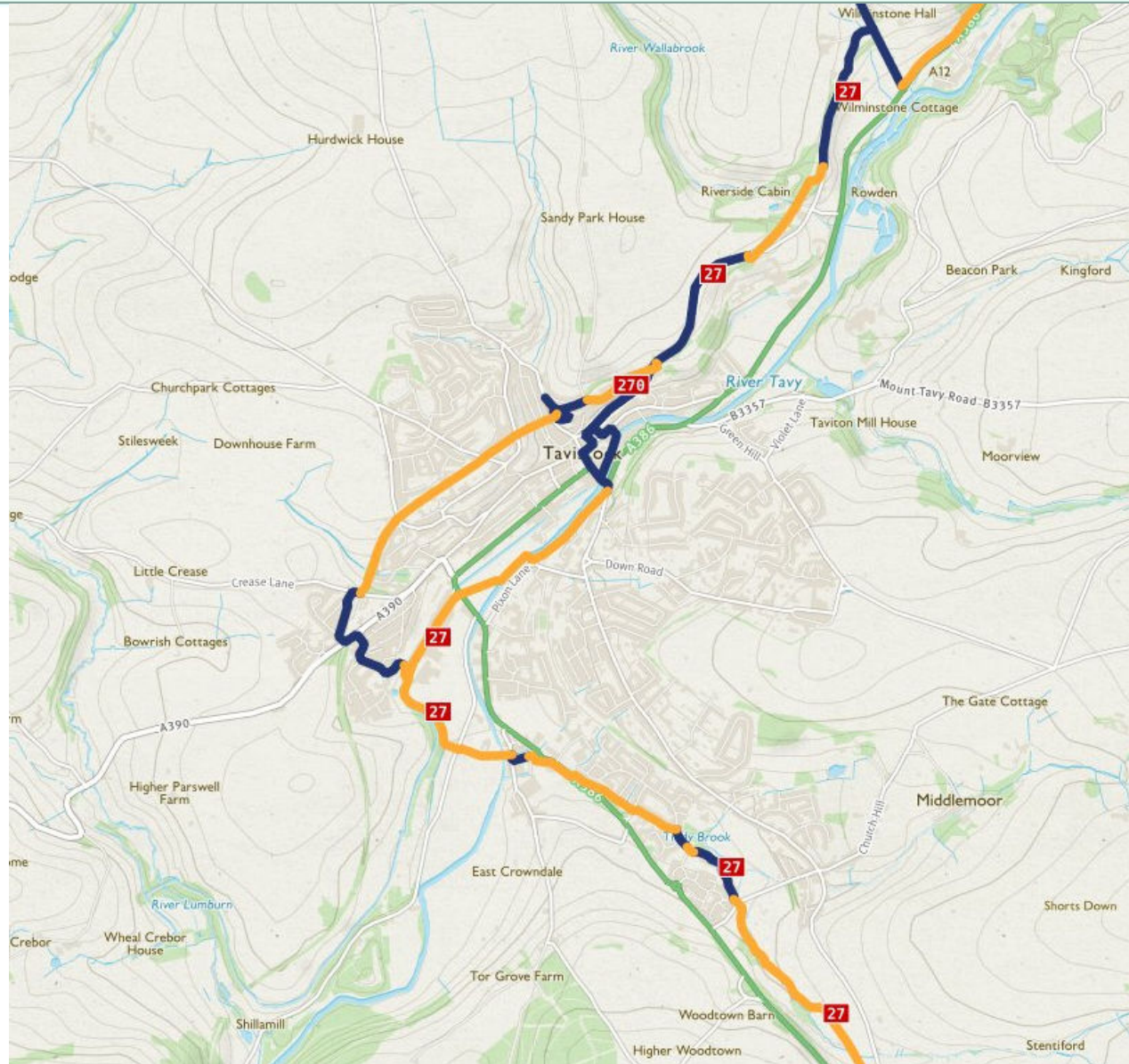

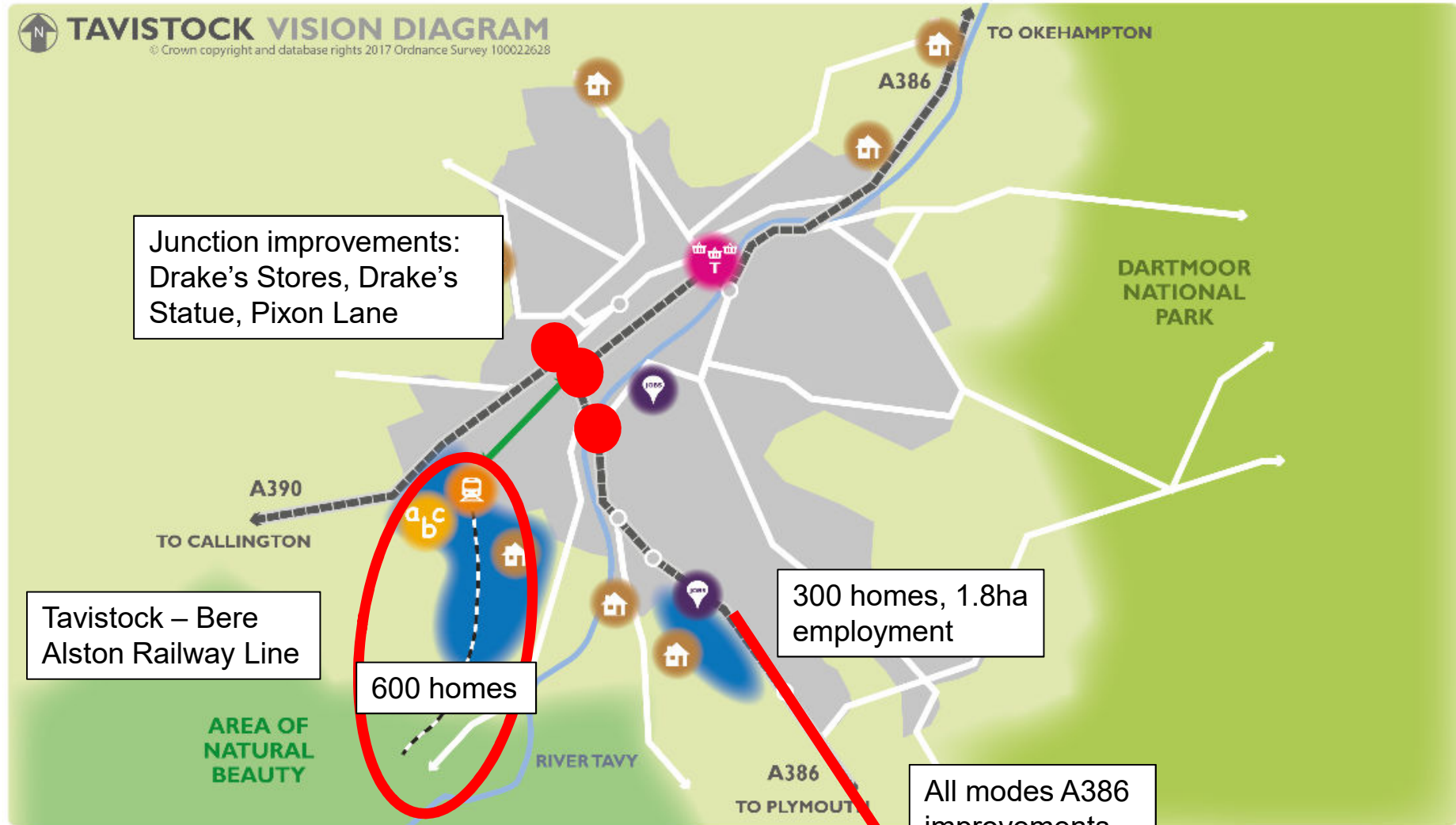
